



4. Flip Books: Create a flip book by folding a piece of paper in half and cutting just the cover down the middle, so that the cover has 2 flaps that are still attached to the rest of the book. Write "predator" on one flap and "prey" on the other flap. On the inside of the flip book, write a definition of each vocab term on the



back of the appropriate flap. In the corresponding portion of the paper on the opposite side of the fold, draw and label 2 examples of each term. This word study strategy can also be used for other terms from the unit, such as:

- a. producer/consumer/decomposer
- b. carnivore/herbivore/omnivore
- c. invasive species/native species

5. **Tic Tac Toe:** Create your own tic tac toe board by placing the following terms in the location of your choice:

Example -

Niche	Producer	Consumer
Carnivore	Herbivore	Omnivore
Decomposer	Food	Energy

Once your board is filled out, use 3 words that are in the same row together (across, down, or diagonal) to make a sentence. Write 4 different sentences using your tic tac toe board.

You may also use this board to play bingo with someone at home – mark off each word as its definition is given.

6. **The Hungry Trout:** Choose an item that you would like to eat from the menu. Make a food chain to show how the energy in the dish you chose can be traced back to the sun.
