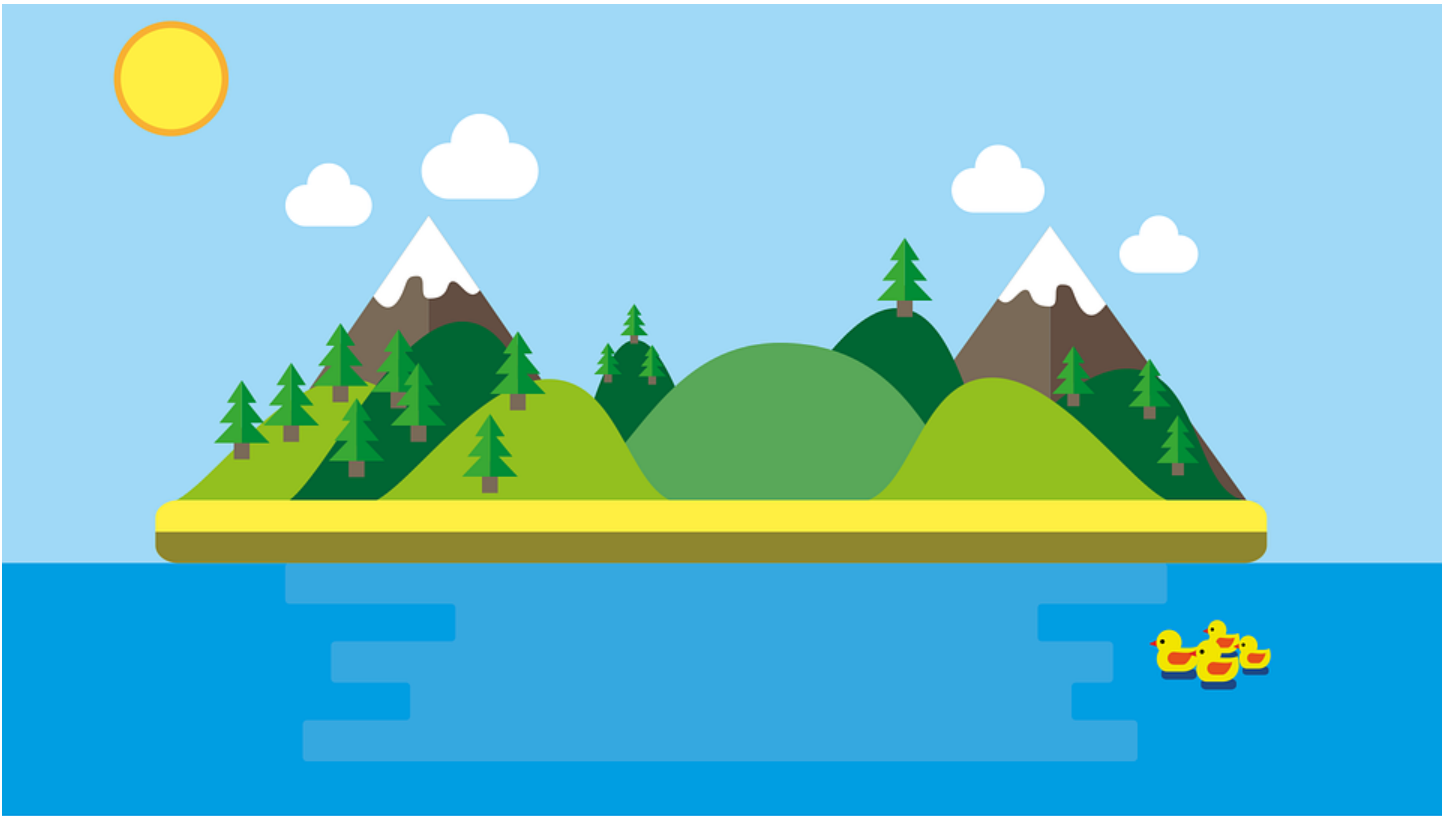

 - d. *Finally*, build a model of your map. Ask someone for help.

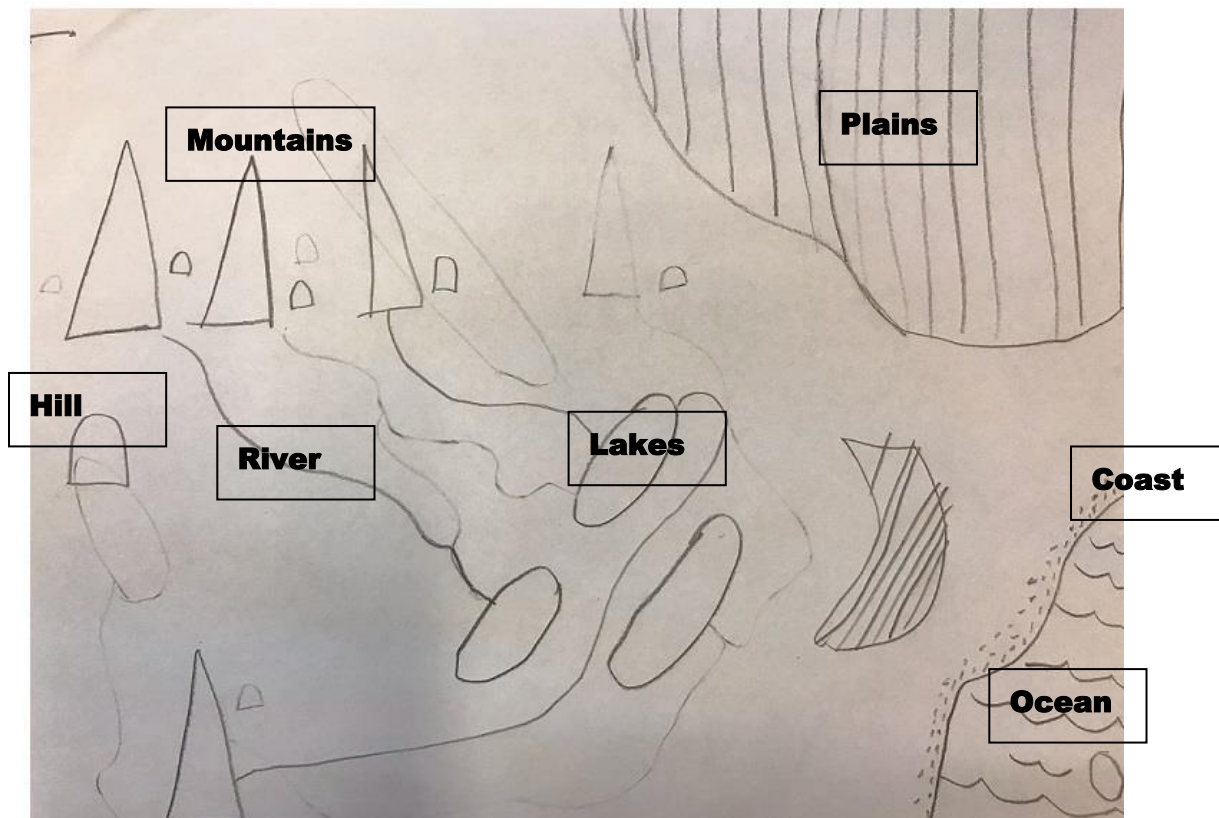
Choose at least 1 land feature:

<input type="checkbox"/> hill (near mountains)	

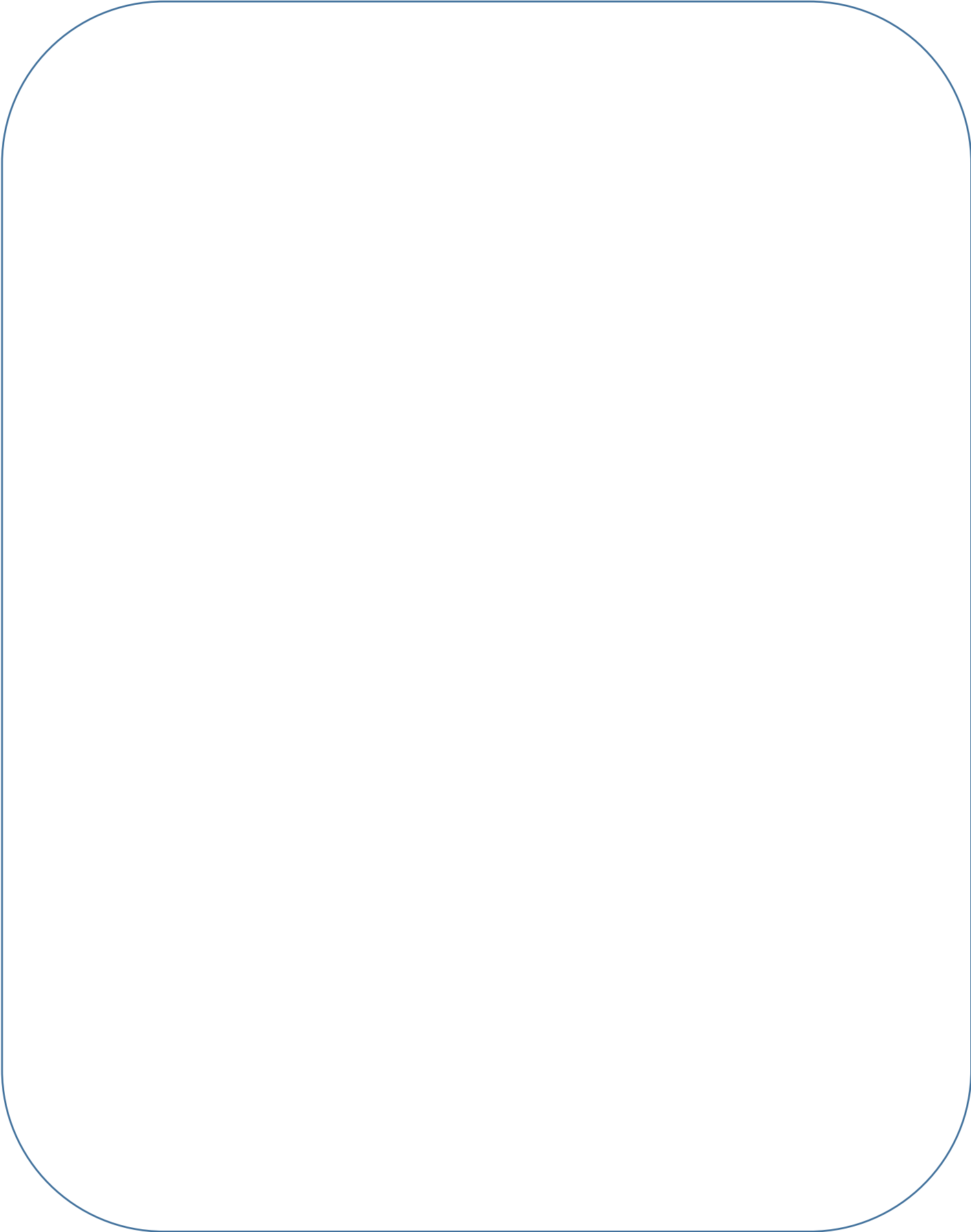
Choose at least 1 water feature:
