
## Dichotomous key for insects



- Wings are covered by an exoskeleton go to step 2.
- Wings are not covered by an exoskeleton go to step 3.
- 2a. Body has a round shape ladybug.
- Body has an elongated shape firefly.
- Wings point outward from the body dragonfly.
- 3b. Wings point toward the rear of the body bee.

## Dichotomous key for rock sample identification



- The rock is black go to step 2.
- The rock is not black go to step 3.
- 2a. The rock has a glassy texture obsidian.
- 2b. The rock does not have a glassy texture slate.
- The rock has bands gneiss.
- 3b. The rock does not have bands go to step 4.
- The rock has large, heavy grains conglomerate.
- 4b. The rock has small grains granite.
